Pinpoint & Pothole Package **(For Larger Projects with Multiple Utilities)**

Private utility locating combined with hydrovac potholing.

Includes private locate, up to an 8-hour day on site locating, potholing and daylighting public and private utilities needed, mobilization fee and one dump fee.

(Additional time or travel billed at standard rates. Scheduled service only. Customer must provide 811 ticket and available utility maps.)

Backfill Package

\$4,500

Includes one dump truck load of M10 granite dust delivered to site, mobilization, equipment and operator to backfill.

(Scheduled service only. **One dump truck load of M10 will typically equal the backfill of one hydrovac truck full tank of removal.** If additional loads/backfilling is needed, contact us for specialized pricing.)

Notes

Billing done in ¼ hour increments · Net 30 terms · Organic material only (no sewage or hazardous waste).

On-site dumping billed as time only with no dump fee. Off-site dumping includes applicable dump fees and billable travel time. Fuel surcharge may apply based on EIA rates.

FAQs

Q: How do I figure out pricing?

A: You can call or email us for an official quote, or use this price sheet to build a rough budget by estimating hours, dump fees, and travel or mobilization costs based on the expected number of days and volume of excavation. In good ground and normal conditions, we can fill a 12 yard truck with 6-8 cubic yards of earth in roughly 4 hours on site hydro-digging. Other soil types may take longer and require more water and collect less material to fill a tank.

Q: If there is a job where I need CPHE to go dump and come back to finish on the same day, how is that charged?

A: When mid-job off-site dumping is required, the dump fee will apply and time remains billable for travel to the dump site, dumping, and return to the job site. An additional dump fee will be charged at the end of the day for the final load collected. Overtime hourly fees will also apply if the work day becomes longer than 8 hours on site including this mid job dumping time.

Q: If I have a space CPHE can dump on site what would be my charge for that?

A: On-site dumping is billed as time only, with no additional dump fees.

Q: What is Remote Work?

A: If the excavation area is more than 22 feet from the hydrovac truck's accessible parking location, additional vacuum hose or piping will be installed to extend reach to the work area.

Q: When would a 2" Submersible Pump be used?

A: This water pump is used to remove clean water from the surface of a pit prior to or during excavation. By discharging clean water onto the ground, it preserves hydrovac tank capacity for soil and slurry, allowing crews to prioritize excavation below the water line and avoid filling the tank with unnecessary volume. Use is performed at the customer's request when conditions warrant.

Q: Do you handle Sewage?

A: CPHE only handles Organic material. Organic Material = Dirt/ Water/ Rocks/ Mud Only - No Sewage or Hazardous Waste (CPHE does not handle Sewage or Hazardous Waste)
